SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER ETHICS

As a member of my local Board of Trustees I will strive to improve public education and, to that end, I will do the following:

- 1. Attend all regularly scheduled Board and respective committee meetings insofar as possible, and become informed concerning the issues to be considered at those meetings.
- 2. Recognize that I should endeavour to make policy decisions only after full discussion at committee and Board meetings.
- 3. Render all decisions based on the available facts and my independent judgement, and refuse to surrender that judgement to individuals or special interest groups.
- 4. Encourage the free expression of opinion by all Board members and use the proper channels of communication for the exchange of information with students, staff and community.
- 5. Work with other Board members to establish effective Board policies and to delegate authority for the administration of the schools to the senior administrative staff.
- 6. Communicate to other Board members and senior administrative staff expressions of public reaction to Board policies and school programs.
- 7. Inform myself about current educational issues by individual study and through participation in programs providing needed information.
- 8. Support the employment of those persons best qualified to serve as school staff, and insist on a regular impartial evaluation of all staff.
- 9. Avoid being placed in a position of conflict of interest and refrain from using my Board position for personal or partisan gain.
- 10. Take no private action that will compromise the Board or administration, and respect the confidentiality of information that is privileged.
- 11. Remember always that my first and greatest concern must be the educational welfare of the students attending the schools of the Portage la Prairie School Division.
